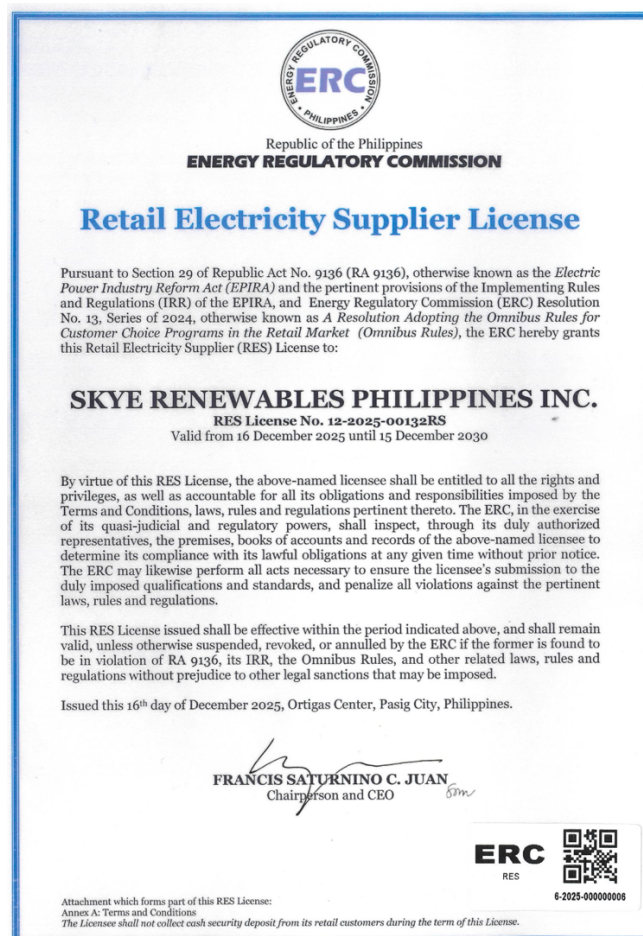


**Skye Renewables Philippines is granted Retail Electricity Supplier License**
